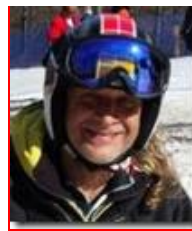

Wednesday, Jan 16: GS training (morning). GS timed runs (afternoon). "Boot Camp" (high performance boot fitting Q&A) and après-ski party at First Trax Ski Shop.

Thursday, Jan 17: Slalom training. Free evening.

Friday, Jan 18: Slalom training. Closing reception with refreshments and door prizes, Main Lodge (3rd floor)

COST*:

Early Bird Registration (before January 1, 2019): **Only \$375!**

Regular cost (January 1, 2019 or later): **\$475**

Can only come to part of the camp? We'll prorate your camp tuition based on the number of days you can attend: \$95per day (\$120 per day if you register January 1, 2019 or later).

**Camp tuition includes everything on-site except lift tickets (\$39 per day), lodging and meals.*

LODGING DEAL:

Snow Lake Lodge



Located at the south entrance of Mount Snow, 1/8 mile from the slopes. Free shuttle service from the lodge to the base area. 12-person indoor hot tub, sauna, outdoor Jacuzzi, game room.

Hotel Room: 2 double beds or 1 king
\$69/night + taxes/resort fees (about \$84/night total), includes breakfast

Suite: Two rooms with a common hallway. One bedroom with one king bed or two double beds, 1 bath room, full living room area with double sleeper sofa, small refrigerator, table, 2 TV's.
\$89/night + taxes/resort fees (about \$108/night total), includes breakfast
